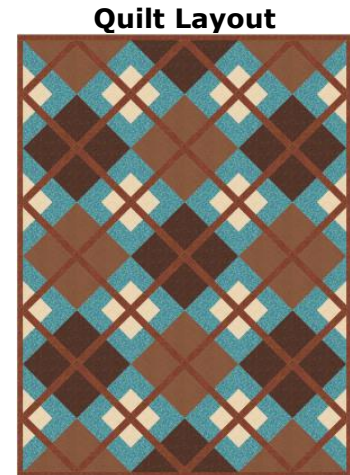

Supply List

Fabric & Batting	
Front – Fabric A	2/3 yd
Front – Fabric B	1 ½ yds
Front – Fabric C	1 yd
Front – Fabric D	1 yd
Sashing & Binding	2 yds
Back	3 yds or 24 assorted 13" squares
Hobbs Heirloom Fusible Batting 96" wide (see Notes)	2 yds or Queen size package

Notes

- Please only use the **Hobb's Heirloom Fusible batting** available by the yard at Meissner's. Do **not** use polyester batting or June Taylor fusible batting. If you cannot get the Hobb's fusible, you may use low-loft cotton batting and temporary adhesive spray such as Sulky KK2000.

Before class:

- Cut fabric (all "strips" are cut the width of the fabric – selvage to selvage)
 - Fabric A – Cut (5) 3 ¾" strips, recut into (48) 3 ¾" squares
 - Fabric B – Cut (5) 3 ½" strips, recut into (48) 3 ¾" x 3 ½" rectangles
 - Fabric B – Cut (8) 3 ½" strips, recut into (48) 3 ½" x 6 ¾" rectangles
 - Fabric C – Cut (5) 6 ¾" strips, recut into (25) 6 ¾" squares
 - Fabric D – Cut (4) 6 ¾" strips, recut into (23) 6 ¾" squares
 - Fabric F – Cut at least (2) 14" squares (you will need 24 total)
 - Batting – Cut at least (2) 14" squares (you will need 24 total)
 - The remaining fabric and batting will be cut after the first class
