Supply List

Fabric & Batting	Qty
Fabric A for sashing, binding and block centers	2/3 yd
Fabric B for block corners and backs	1/2 yd
Fabric C for borders	2/3 yd
Batting – Hobb’s Fusible batting or low-loft cotton batting and temporary adhesive spray such as Sulky KK2000. Do not use June Taylor fusible batting! You will not be happy with the results. The Hobb’s fusible is a temporary fusible on both sides.	1 square yard



Finished size = 24" square

Before class:

- The block centers are 5" square. If you would like to do an embroidered design or fussy cut fabric, please do it before class and have it trimmed to 5" square.
- Cut the following:
 - From fabric A
 - (3) 1 3/4" strips cut selvage to selvage for front sashing
 - (3) 1 1/8" strips cut selvage to selvage for back sashing
 - (3) 2 1/2" strips cut selvage to selvage for binding
 - (4) 5" squares for block centers
 - From fabric B
 - (8) 9" squares for block corners and backs
 - From fabric C
 - (3) 3" strips cut selvage to selvage for front borders
 - (3) 3 1/2" strips cut selvage to selvage for back borders
