Fabrics - Front	
Blocks & Appliqué	2 contrasting fabrics, ¼ yd each
Sashing	¼ yd
Border	½ yd
Binding	¼ yd
Fabrics - Back	
Block Backs	2/3 yd
Sashing	¼ yd
Border	½ yd
Binding	¼ yd
Notions	
Appliqué	½ yd Steam-a-Seam 2
Batting	½ yd. Hobbs Heirloom Fusible Batting (96" wide)
Template Plastic	1 sheet
Thread for piecing	1 spool neutral colored cotton thread
Thread for appliqué and quilting	1 spool colored cotton or rayon thread for appliqué/quilting
Monofilament thread	1 spool invisible/monofilament thread (if you're using dark fabrics, you may want to use the smoke colored monofilament)

Notes

- We will be making a wall hanging size (25" x 31") quilt in class so you can learn all the techniques needed to make a larger appliqué quilt. The instructions handed out in class will include fabric requirements for a 30 block lap size quilt.
- Please only use the **Hobb's Heirloom Fusible batting** available by the yard at Meissner's. Do not use polyester batting or June Taylor fusible batting. If you cannot get the Hobb's fusible, you may use low-loft cotton batting and temporary adhesive spray such as Sulky KK2000.
