





Sewing Machine (with power cord, foot pedal, and needles!) ## **Notes**

Please only use the Hobb's Heirloom Fusible batting available by the yard at Meissner's. Do not use polyester batting or June Taylor fusible batting. If you cannot get the Hobb's fusible, you may use low-loft cotton batting and temporary adhesive spray such as Sulky KK2000.

## **Before class:**

- Cut fabric (all "strips" are cut the width of the fabric selvage to selvage)
  - o Fabric A Cut (5) 3 ¾" strips, recut into (48) 3 ¾" squares
  - o Fabric B Cut (5) 3 ½" strips, recut into (48) 3 ¾" x 3 ½" rectangles
  - o Fabric B Cut (8) 3 ½" strips, recut into (48) 3 ½" x 6 ¾" rectangles
  - o Fabric C Cut (5) 6 34" strips, recut into (25) 6 34" squares
  - o Fabric D Cut (4) 6 34" strips, recut into (23) 6 34" squares
  - Fabric F Cut at least (2) 14" squares (you will need 24 total)
  - o Batting Cut at least (2) 14" squares (you will need 24 total)
  - o The remaining fabric and batting will be cut after the first class
