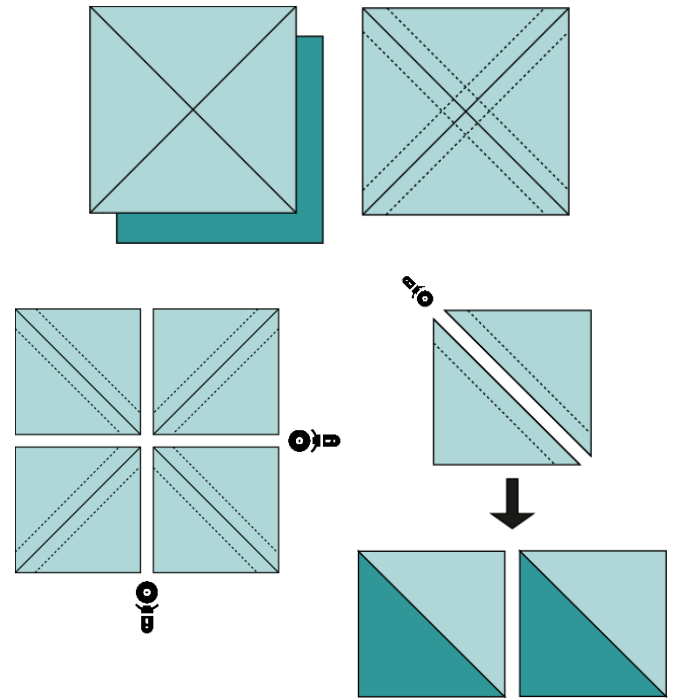


# 8 AT-A-TIME HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE CHEAT SHEET

This is a quick method for making half-square triangles (HSTs) when you need eight identical units. I like to make my half-square triangles a little bit larger and then trim them down to the exact size. Use the table below to determine the size to cut your squares.

HST Unfinished Size	HST Finished Size	Cut 2 Squares
1	½	3

- Draw a diagonal lines on the wrong side of one square
- Place the square on top of another square, right sides together
- Sew ¼" on each side of each drawn line
- Cut the square into four equal quadrants
- Cut the quadrants apart on the drawn line
- Trim the HST units to the UNFINISHED size

All measurements are in inches
