## Notes

- Please only use the Hobb's Heirloom Fusible batting. Do not use polyester batting or June Taylor fusible batting. If you cannot get the Hobb's fusible, you may use low-loft cotton batting and temporary adhesive spray such as Sulky KK2000.
- Fabric selection tips:
- This pattern will also work with pre-cut layer cakes. You will need four 10 " squares for each block.
- Use a contrasting fabric for the block corners, sashing and binding to show off your focus fabrics
- Before class: Please have your fabric cut prior to class. You may cut all of it, or just the minimum needed in class. All strips are cut width of fabric (WOF).
